

TREGONY CONTEMPORARY *IN RESIDENCE*

WORKSHOP AGREEMENT

ERIN RAEDEKE – Capturing Colour in the Landscape

Caerhays Estate, Cornwall.

4 – 11 June 2026

1. Workshop Itinerary

The workshop follows a carefully planned programme; however, a degree of flexibility may be required. Cornwall can be unpredictable (especially the weather), and from time to time we may need to adjust the order or timing of activities. Any changes will be made thoughtfully and communicated in advance, ensuring participants receive the full workshop experience as outlined.

2. Venue Change

In the unlikely event that the advertised workshop venue becomes unavailable for reasons beyond Tregony Contemporary's control, Tregony Contemporary reserves the right to provide an alternative venue of equivalent standard within the same geographic area. Participants will be notified promptly of any change.

3. Workshop Cancellation by Tregony Contemporary

If Tregony Contemporary needs to cancel the workshop for any reason, including insufficient enrolment, all fees paid to Tregony Contemporary will be refunded in full within 14 days of cancellation. In this event, Tregony Contemporary cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs incurred by participants, including travel or accommodation arrangements not made directly by Tregony Contemporary.

Tregony Contemporary will not be liable for cancellations arising from circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to war, civil unrest, industrial action, terrorist activity, natural disaster, fire, or government travel restrictions.

Should the named art instructor be unable to attend, Tregony Contemporary reserves the right to appoint a suitably qualified replacement instructor or, if necessary, to cancel the workshop. If the workshop is cancelled, all payments made to Tregony Contemporary will be refunded as outlined above. In the event

that an instructor becomes ill or injured during the workshop and is fully unable to teach, participants will be reimbursed £100 per day for each full day of missed instruction.

4. Participant Cancellation Policy

A place on the workshop is confirmed upon receipt of the **£750 non-refundable deposit** and completion of the booking form. The balance of workshop fees is payable by the date stated on the booking form.

If a participant needs to cancel their place, written notice must be provided to Tregony Contemporary. The following cancellation terms apply:

- **More than 120 days prior to the workshop start date** – A refund of all fees paid will be issued, less the non-refundable £750 deposit.
- **120 days or fewer prior to the workshop start date** – A refund of **50% of fees paid**, excluding the non-refundable deposit, will be issued **only if** Tregony Contemporary is able to fill the vacated place.
- **Within 30 days of the workshop start date** – No refund will be issued, for any reason.

Participants acknowledge that Tregony Contemporary commits significant costs in advance, including venues, accommodation, staffing, and catering, and that replacing a participant at short notice may not be possible. Participants are therefore strongly advised to arrange comprehensive travel insurance that includes cover for workshop cancellation.

5. Travel Insurance

Tregony Contemporary does not provide travel insurance and cannot accept responsibility for costs unless expressly stated in this Agreement. Participants are **strongly advised to arrange comprehensive personal travel insurance** to cover items such as airline or rail tickets, loss or delay of luggage, trip disruption, medical expenses or evacuation, accommodation costs, workshop fees, and any other related expenses.

6. Participant Expectations

Participants assume certain responsibilities, risks, and obligations to fellow participants, the instructor, and Tregony Contemporary, including but not limited to:

- **Physical activity** – Foreign travel and painting classes involve moderate physical activity. Participants should be capable of carrying their own painting gear over short distances and walking moderate distances over uneven surfaces, such as country lanes and coastal paths. Tregony Contemporary will attempt to accommodate special needs but cannot guarantee this.
- **Venue accessibility** – Many venues were chosen for their historic or scenic nature and may not have lifts. Assistance with luggage can be provided, but participants with difficulty navigating stairs should confirm suitability with Tregony Contemporary.

- **Group dynamics** – While there is time for personal painting and exploration, this is a group experience. Meals, excursions, and classes are largely communal. Disruptive or uncooperative participants may diminish the experience for others. Tregony Contemporary reserves the right to expel participants acting in a manner incompatible with the safety or enjoyment of others, without refund.
- **Allergies and dietary requirements** – With sufficient notice, Tregony Contemporary will work with the venue chef to accommodate reasonable dietary restrictions. Severe allergies should be discussed with Tregony Contemporary prior to booking.

7. COVID-19

The risk of contracting COVID-19 is the sole responsibility of the participant. Standard cancellation terms will apply. Tregony Contemporary does not mandate specific precautions but strongly recommends that all participants are fully vaccinated and boosted. Governmental entities, airlines, hotels, restaurants, and other vendors may impose COVID-19 restrictions which may change with little notice. Participants are responsible for complying with these requirements.

8. Liability

Participants acknowledge that foreign travel may involve risks such as illness, personal injury, political unrest, natural disasters, or other unforeseen circumstances. Tregony Contemporary and its owners are only responsible for providing the accommodation and classes outlined above. Participants waive all claims against Tregony Contemporary, its owners, and employees for personal injury or damages arising from any cause, except in cases of gross negligence. Tregony Contemporary is not responsible for changes, delays, cancellations, or other unforeseeable occurrences except as specified above.

9. Dispute Resolution

In the event of a dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, participants agree to engage in good faith mediation with Tregony Contemporary before commencing arbitration or litigation.

10. Governing Law

This Agreement, and any purchases made through it, are governed by **English law** and will be deemed to have occurred in the United Kingdom.
